NOTICE OF ACTION TAKEN DISMISSING APPLICATIONS -- VARIOUS DOCKETS

This serves as notice to the public of the actions described below, taken on the date shown above by the Department official indicated (no additional confirming order will be issued in this matter).

The carriers listed below have applied for various forms of authority or relief under Title 49 of the United States Code in order to perform the air transportation activities described. Each application has either been withdrawn by the applicant or otherwise become moot. Therefore, we find that these applications should be dismissed, under authority assigned by the Department in its Regulations, 14 CFR § 385.3 and 383.13.

OST-95-714	Aerovias Nacionales Ecuatorianas Manabitas, S.A. (Aronem) , filed October 6, 1995. Foreign air carrier permit to engage in charter foreign air transportation of property and mail between Ecuador and the United States. Information available to the Department indicates that Aronem has no plans to prosecute this application.
48148	Alitalia-Linee Aeree Italiane-S.p.A. , filed May 7, 1993, and May 18, 1995. Renew exemption, last granted May 18, 1992, and confirmed by Order 93-3-3, to engage in scheduled foreign air transportation of persons, property and mail between Italy and Miami, FL. By Notice of Action Taken, dated December 7, 1999, in Docket OST-99-6500, we granted Alitalia exemption authority which encompasses the authority at issue here.
48324	Alitalia-Linee Aeree Italiane-S.p.A. , filed August 16, 1993. Renew exemption, last granted September 2, 1992, and confirmed by Order 95-1-15, to engage in scheduled foreign air transportation of property and mail between Italy and Los Angeles, CA. By Notice of Action Taken, dated December 7, 1999, in Docket OST-99-6500, we granted Alitalia exemption authority which encompasses the authority at issue here.
45587	Caledonian Airways Limited , filed April 11, 1989. Renew exemption, last granted April 15, 1988, and confirmed by Order 88-10-47, to engage in charter foreign air transportation of persons and property between the United Kingdom and the United States. By Notice of Action Taken, dated April 25, 2000, we granted JMC Airlines Limited, the successor company to Caledonian, exemption authority which encompasses the authority at issue here.
OST-97-2097 OST-97-2098	Flying Colours Airline Limited , filed January 24, 1997, and February 25, 1998. Foreign air carrier permit to engage in charter foreign air transportation of persons and property between the United Kingdom and the United States. Renew exemption, last granted April 7, 1997, and confirmed by Order 97-7-19, to engage in charter foreign air transportation of persons and property. By Notice of Action Taken, dated April 25, 2000, we granted JMC Airlines Limited, the successor company to Flying Colours, exemption authority which encompasses the authority at issue here.
OST-99-5548	KLM Royal Dutch Airlines , filed April 16, 1999. Renew statement of authorization, last approved April 16, 1997, to allow KLM to carry the designator code of Northwest Airlines, Inc., on KLM flights between Amsterdam and Aarhus, Denmark. On May 21, 1999, we granted KLM's June 25, 1998, undocketed application (#98-348) for a statement of authorization which encompasses the authority at issue here.

Disposition

Action: We dismiss the applications described above.
