ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

On October 1, 2001, Pacific Airways, Inc., filed an application in Docket OST-01-10748 requesting a certificate pursuant to section 41102 to allow it to engage in interstate scheduled passenger operations primarily throughout Southeast Alaska from its hub in Ketchikan. On several occasions since that date, we requested additional information in order to complete our review. While a good deal of that information was supplied,¹ the information we have to date continues to be insufficient to complete the processing of the application. We most recently requested information in early June. Although we have granted Pacific Airways several extensions to submit this material, we have still not received it. On July 16, we advised Pacific Airways that because of the administrative burdens involved in maintaining incomplete applications on file indefinitely, if we did not receive the information by July 23, we intended to dismiss its application. That deadline elapsed with no response from the carrier.

In light of the above, we have decided to dismiss Pacific Airways' application in Docket OST-01-10748 without prejudice to the company's refiling its application at some future time.

¹ Pacific Airways submitted supplemental information pertaining to its application on the following dates: December 5, 2001; January 29, 2002; May 10, 2002; May 15, 2002; and June 12, 2002.

ACCORDINGLY, Acting under authority assigned by the Department in its regulations, 14 CFR 385.12:

1. We dismiss, without prejudice, the application filed in Docket OST-01-10748 by Pacific Airways, Inc.
2. We will serve a copy of this order on the persons listed in Attachment A.

Persons entitled to petition the Department for review of this order under the Department's Regulations, 14 CFR 385.30, may file their petitions within 10 days of the service date of this order.

This order shall be effective and become the final action of the Department of Transportation upon the expiration of the above period unless within such period a petition for review is filed or the Department gives notice that it will review this order on its own motion.
