**PT AIRFAST INDONESIA VIOLATIONS OF 49 U.S.C SECTION 41301:**

The Department (1) approves this settlement and the provisions of the order as being in the public interest; (2) finds that PT Airfast Indonesia violated 49 U.S.C. Section 41301 by operating round-trip flights between Timika, Indonesia, and Guam during 1999, without proper authority; (3) orders PT Airfast Indonesia, and all other entities owned or controlled by or under common ownership with PT Airfast Indonesia, and their successors and assignees, to cease and desist from violations of 49 U.S.C. Section 41301; and (4) assesses PT Airfast Indonesia \$30,000 in compromise of civil penalties that might otherwise be assessed for the violations.
