**APPLICATION OF DELTA AIR LINES, INC. FOR A PERMANENT ALLOCATION OF U.S.-BRAZIL COMBINATION SERVICE FREQUENCIES FOR ATLANTA-RIO DE JANEIRO SERVICE:**

The Department grants dormancy waiver extensions to Continental Airlines and American Airlines through December 31, 2002, and January 8, 2003, respectively, with respect to their U.S.-Brazil service frequency allocations. Additionally, the Department grants the application of Delta Air Lines for a temporary, indefinite allocation of four weekly U.S.-Brazil service frequencies for continuation of its Atlanta-Rio de Janeiro services. Finally, the Department defers action on the application of Delta for a permanent allocation of four weekly U.S.-Brazil service frequencies.

**Notice of Market-based Actions to Relieve Airport Congestion and Delay**

This action establishes a new closing date for the comment period in DOT's request for public comment on possible market-based approaches to relieving airport congestion and delay. After the September 11 terrorist attacks, DOT indefinitely suspended the closing date for the comment period.
