**Economic Enforcement Consent
Orders - 2003**

Order 2003-4-9, the Department (1) approves the settlement and the provisions of this order as being in the public interest, (2) finds that Icelandair, Inc., violated 14 CFR 399.84 by advertising promotional fares on its Internet site and in e-mail advertisements which separately stated an insurance surcharge and failed to disclose adequately all additional taxes and fees, (3) finds that by engaging in the conduct Icelandair, Inc., violated 49 U.S.C. Section 41712; and, (4) orders Icelandair, Inc., its successors, affiliates, and assigns, to cease and desist from further similar violations of 14 CFR 399.84 and 49 U.S.C. Section 41712.
