Inquiry Into the Citizenship and Foreign Control of DHL Airways, Inc.

Order 2003-7-36, the Department (1) extends the deadline for the Recommended Decision in this case for 30 days; (2) affirms the decisions of Chief Administrative Law Judge Ronnie A. Yoder (Chief Judge) denies the Motion of ASTAR Air Cargo, Inc., formerly known as DHL Airways, Inc. (ASTAR) to terminate the proceeding in this docket, and denies the motion of DHL Holdings (USA), Inc. (Holdings), and DHL Worldwide Express, Inc. (Worldwide Express) for a declaratory order finding this proceeding to be moot; (3) further, defers consideration of the non-citizenship aspects of the continuing fitness of ASTAR under its new ownership until the conclusion of this proceeding; and, (4) also makes clear that the scope of this proceeding, including discover, and the relevance of facts involved therein, is to be limited to the current citizenship of ASTAR as it now exists.

Certificate/Transfer Interstate/Foreign Charter Air Transportation

Order 2003-7-37, the Department tentatively finds Kalitta Charters II, LLC (KC II) fit, willing, and able to engage in the interstate and foreign charter air transportation of property and mail and proposes to transfer to KC II the authority contained in the interstate and foreign cargo charter certificate currently held by Reliant Airlines, Inc. (Reliant) subject to conditions.

2003-7-39 OST-2003-14194 **Economic Enforcement Consent Orders - 2003** 07/31/2003

Order 2003-7-39, the Department

(1) approves this settlement and the provisions of this order as being in the public interest; (2) finds that America West Airlines, Inc. violated 14 CFR 399.84 by causing to be published an advertisement that failed to state the entire price to be paid by the customer to the air carrier, or agent, for certain air transportation; (3) finds that by engaging in the conduct and violation, America West, Inc., also violated 49 U.S.C. Section 41712; and, (4) orders America West Airlines, Inc., and all other entities owned or controlled by or under common ownership with America West Airlines, Inc., and their successors and assignees, to cease and desist from violations of 49 U.S.C. Section 41712 and 14 CFR 399.84.
