**Economic Enforcement Consent
Orders - 2004**

Order 2004-4-22, the Department (1) approves the settlement and the provisions of this order as being in the public interest; (2) finds that ATA Airlines, Inc., violated the requirements of 14 CFR Section 382.21(a)(2) by failing to provide space to stow one passenger's standard-size folding wheelchair in the passenger cabin of its aircraft ordered by ATA Airlines, Inc., after April 5, 1990, or delivered to ATA Airlines, Inc., after April 5, 1992; (3) finds that ATA by committing the violation, violated the Air Carrier Access Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 41705; (4) finds that to the extent the violations occurred in interstate air transportation, the conduct violated 49 U.S.C. Section 41702; (5) finds that the violations involved unfair and deceptive practices and, thereby, violated 49 U.S.C. Section 41712; and, (6) The Department orders ATA Airlines, Inc., and its successors and assigns to cease and desist from further violations of 14 CFR Section 382.21(a)(2) and 49 U.S.C. Sections 41702, 41705, and 41712 by engaging in the conduct.
