Generally speaking, fares increase between two to five percent, with isolated increases of up to 15 percent, while rule amendments include revised seasonal definitions, minimum/maximum stay requirements and refund procedures. The agreement in Docket OST-95-882 adopts a variety of changes applicable to travel within Europe. These include specification of fares to/from points in the former Soviet Union; cancellation of peak season economy class fares from Germany with conversion of existing basis season levels to all-year application; transfer of application periods for special fares, now shown in the fare tables, to either the individual fare resolution or to fare table notes; and minor adjustments to fare levels in certain selected markets.
