The Department exempts Airline Management Limited from Section 41301 of Title 49 of the U.S. Code to permit it to engage in charter foreign air transportation of persons and property between any point or points in the United Kingdom and any point or points in the United States, either directly or via intermediate or beyond points in other countries, with or without stopovers; and between any point or points in the United States and point or points not in the United Kingdom or the United States; and other charters pursuant to 14 CFR 212 of the Department's regulations, effective immediately and to remain in effect for one year after issue date. The Department grants a statement of authorization to permit Airline Management Limited to conduct wet-lease operations on behalf of British Airways PLC between London (Gatwick)-Tampa and between London (Gatwick)-San Juan. This authority is subject to the charter provisions of the Air Services Agreement between the U. S and the U.K. and Northern Ireland. The Department grants the motions for extension of time to file and for leave to file otherwise unauthorized documents.
