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APPLICATION OF AMERICAN AIRLINES, INC. FOR A WAIVER OF 14 CFR 201.5

The Department awards, on a *pendente lite* basis, authority for new services to Japan, as described in this order, to American Airlines, Inc., Continental Airlines, Inc., and Delta Air Lines, Inc. It also allocates to each of these carriers a total of seven weekly frequencies for these services. The exemption authority and frequency allocations will be effective immediately for a period of one year, or until 90 days after a final decision in the 1998

U. S.-Japan Combination Service proceeding in Docket OST-98-3419, whichever occurs earlier.
