CODE-SHARING VIOLATIONS: The Department approves this settlement and the provisions of this order as being in the public interest and finds that Northwest Airlines, Inc. has violated 14 CFR 399.88(2) and Order 87-11-33 and 91-8-17 by failing to provide adequate disclosure of code-sharing arrangements to consumers. Therefore, the Department orders Northwest Airlines, Inc. to cease and desist from the activities described. Northwest Airlines is assessed \$45,000 as a compromise of civil penalties that might otherwise be assessed for the violations described in ordering paragraph 2 of this order. CODE-SHARING VIOLATIONS: The Department approves this settlement and the provisions of this order as being in the public interest and finds that Delta Air Lines, Inc., has violated 14 CFR 399.88(2) and Order 91-8-41 by failing to provide adequate disclosure of code-sharing arrangements to consumers. Therefore, the Department orders Delta Air Lines, Inc. to cease and desist from the activities described and Delta Air Lines, Inc. shall pay \$25,000 as a compromise of civil penalties that might otherwise be assessed for the violations described in ordering paragraph 2 of this order.
