SECTIONS 41101, 41301 AND 41712, AND 14 CFR PART 212:</p> <p>This consent order concerns the unauthorized operation of flights between the Netherlands, the United States and Canada, by Alaska Airlines, Inc. ("Alaska") and Horizon Air Industries, Inc. ("Horizon"), and KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, Inc. ("KLM"), that constitute violations of 49 U.S.C. Sections 41101, 41301 and 41712, and 14 CFR Part 212.
